International Order of the Rainbow for Girls

Parental Release form for Chaperoned Activities

1. Assemblies of Missouri will use the official Missouri Parental Release form.
2. The form will be completed by the parents or legal guardians of all Rainbow girls and Pledges annually in January of each year. New member forms will be completed by their parent/legal guardian at the time of initiation.
3. The form will be kept on file by the Mother Advisor or Pledge Mother of each assembly.
4. This form should be taken by the Mother Advisor/Pledge Mother or their designee to each assembly activity whether taking place at the location of the assembly meeting or when traveling to another location for the activity.
5. The parent/legal guardian will indicate on the form if they give permission for their daughter to be transported in a vehicle driven by an older Rainbow Girl age 18-21.
6. Information regarding any medical problems, medications, allergies will be indicated on the form.
7. The parent will provide information regarding insurance coverage on their daughter.

Transportation of Rainbow Girls and Pledges

1. Transportation of Rainbow Girls and Pledges will be addressed on the Missouri Parental Release form.
2. Rainbow Girls and Pledges may be transported in private vehicles owned and/or driven by qualified adult chaperones. Qualified adult chaperones are those who have participated in Youth Protection Training and have completed a successful background check. This includes rented vehicles or church owned vehicles.
3. Rainbow Girls who are age 18-20, with the permission of their parent/legal guardian, may drive themselves in their own private vehicle to assembly activities.
4. Parents/legal guardians will indicate on the parental release form if their daughter may be transported by an older Rainbow Girl age 18-20.
5. The older Rainbow Girl must possess a valid driver's license and must provide proof to the Mother Advisor of her assembly when they drive themselves or transport others to assembly activities. The older Rainbow Girls parent/legal guardian must indicate on her parental release form that they give permission for their daughter to drive to assembly activities and for their daughter to transport other Rainbow Girls to assembly activities.
6. Rainbow Girls driving on Drivers Permits may not drive with other Rainbow Girls in the car.
